

Daniels Fund Scholarship

What is the Daniels Fund Scholarship?

- The Daniels Scholarship is an exciting, challenging, and competitive scholarship program that provides the opportunity to obtain a four-year college education at any accredited nonprofit college or university in the United States, complete with financial and personal support throughout the journey
- **Daniels Scholarship recipients may attend any two or four-year, nonprofit accredited college or university in the United States.**

What does the scholarship entail?

- Cost of Tuition and Fees (renewable up to 4 years if all requirements of the Daniels Scholarship Program are met)
- Room and Board
- Books and Supplies
- Miscellaneous educational expenses

How do you qualify for the Daniels Scholarship Program?

- Demonstrate **financial need**
- Be a **citizen or permanent resident of the United States**
- Be a **resident of Colorado, New Mexico, Utah, or Wyoming**
- Be a **high school senior** graduating from a school in Colorado, New Mexico, Utah, or Wyoming
- Earn a minimum **Grade Point Average of 3.0 in high school** (on an unweighted 4.0 scale), AND earn a minimum **SAT Math score of 490** and a minimum **Evidence-Based Reading & Writing score of 490**, or a minimum **ACT score of 18** in each category (writing score not required). Super scoring is not accepted.
- Demonstrate the Following Characteristics:
 - Strength of character
 - Leadership potential
 - Willingness to give back to the community
 - Academic performance or promise
 - Well-rounded personality

Application Process and Deadlines (PLEASE READ CAREFULLY!):

1. Applications and Recommendations must be submitted online through the application website between **October 1st and November 15th** at 4:00pm MST
2. In addition, students must submit documents that will be used to verify their eligibility, such as their Student Aid Report from the 2019/2020 FAFSA, official ACT/SAT scores, citizenship and residency documentation, and other financial documents
3. Applicants will be notified in **January** whether or not they have been selected as a finalist and finalists will be invited to participate in a personal interview
4. Interviews will be conducted in **February and March**
5. Scholars are announced in **late March** and must attend the scholarship orientation
