# Sample Application Deadlines

## Early Action v. Early Decision (Binding) v. Regular Decision

### Colorado State University

Early Action - Dec. 1st (decision rendered by Dec. 31st)

Regular - Feb. 1st



### University of Denver

Early Action - Nov. 1st (decision rendered by late Dec.)

Regular - Jan. 15th



### University of Colorado-Boulder

Early Action - Nov. 15th (decision rendered by Feb. 1st)

Regular - Jan. 15th



# College Application Deadlines

**Early Action:** early deadline (fall), but it's binding

**Early Decision:** early deadline (fall), you find out decision by around December, not binding

**Regular Decision:** later deadline (usually Jan-Feb), you find out late (April-ish), not binding



# Colorado Free Application Days

**October 15th - 17th** - You must submit your application to the University(ies) by 11:59 pm on Oct. 17th.

Have your application materials prepared, double checked, and ready to submit prior to the 20th!

Some Colleges may have a specific code that you'll have to reference. Others will ask you to identify "Colorado Free Application Day" under their prompt for "*Are you eligible for a fee waiver.*" Research each College's process ahead of time!

Support documents (Letters of Rec, Transcripts, etc) can be submitted after the 20th.

# College Applications

## Common Application

- 1000 diverse colleges and universities; 14 Colorado Schools
- One Application
- Which [schools](#) are on the Common App?

## Directly Through the Institution

- Many schools still use a traditional institution specific application on their website.

# Parts of a College Application

- Demographic Info
  - Address, DOB, email, parent info, etc.
- Essay
  - [Essay Prompt](#)
- Supplemental Questions
  - Varies by school, some have none or they are optional
- Teacher Letter of Recommendation
  - 1-2, varies by school, some do not require any
- Official Transcript
  - Process for requesting from Counselor
- Payment
  - Ranges from \$30-\$90 per school - except on College Free App Day

# Transcript Requests

## Step 1.

If you used Common App, please match your Common App account with Naviance. [Here's how.](#)

## Step 2.

Go to Naviance (in Class Links) > Colleges > Colleges I'm Applying To. To allow for electronic submission of your transcripts, you must add the colleges to which you want transcripts sent.

Be sure to request transcripts at least two weeks prior to your application deadlines to make sure that they arrive on time!



# Letters of Recommendation

  - Ask teacher in-person
    - Give at least two weeks notice
    - Provide them with a [Brag sheet -student profile](#)
    - (Add Recommenders to Naviance)
  - Follow-up in person to thank your teachers!

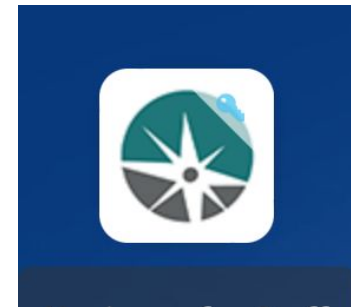
